

HUNT GEAR LIST FOR TEN DAYS

- ___ (3) Long sleeved shirts, wool recommended
- ___ (2) Pair of jeans
- ___ (1or2) Pairs of wool pants
- ___ (1) Leather belt
- ___ (5) Pairs of cotton socks
- ___ (6) Pairs of wool blend socks
- ___ (1) Pair of camp shoes, slippers, or tennis shoes
- ___ (1) Pair of leather hiking boots w/Air-bob or vibram soles
- ___ (1) Pair of rubber-bottomed snow packs
- ___ (10) Pairs of underwear, and 2 Pairs of long handles
- ___ (7) T-shirts
- ___ (2) Handkerchiefs or neck scarfs
- ___ (1) Cap, ear band or hat, wool or felt recommended
- ___ (1) Wool hunting coat
- ___ (1) Vest (optional)
- ___ (1) Set of heavy duty rain gear, or poncho (gaiters are nice)
- ___ (1) Sleeping bag (-5 or warmer)
- ___ (1) Wash cloth & towel set
- ___ Misc. toiletry items (i.e. soap, toothbrush & paste, shampoo, razor & cream, chap stick, moist towels or baby wipes etc...)
- ___ Personal prescription medicine
- ___ (2) Pairs of gloves, insulated
- ___ (1) Pair of field glasses, binoculars
- ___ Hunting license if purchased on your own
- ___ Rifle and 2 boxes of ammo
- ___ Scope cover & cleaning kit
- ___ (1) Knife - 3 _" to 5" blade
- ___ (1) Flashlight w/extra batteries (Mini-Mag)
- ___ (1) Camera w/extra film; videos are welcome
- ___ (1) Cigarette lighter
- ___ (1) Canteen, quart size
- ___ (1) Day pack or fanny pack
- ___ Flag tape for drop campers

This is a recommendation for a ten-day hunting trip. The gear listed should prepare you for the worst of weather -- it's better to be safe than sorry. All of this gear, including the sleeping bag should fit into one army style duffle bag. DO NOT bring any suitcases. Try to keep the weight down to around 50 pounds. We will pack beer and liquor into the camp, however we cannot legally supply it. ***Hunter's orange is not required in Idaho.***
