

We need to have you in our base camp the evening before your hunt begins. If you are driving, you will be able to drive right to our base camp with the directions below. If you are flying, please try to land in Missoula, Montana around noon the day before your hunt. We will pick you up at the airport, probably run a few errands and be in camp that evening. If your plans won't allow for a noon arrival, we have a room rate with the Holiday Inn Parkside in Missoula. The Holiday Inn room rate is \$69 plus tax, their phone number is 800-399-0402, and our club number is #102.

From the East and South:

To save an hour or two, you can bypass Missoula and take a beautiful drive through the Big Hole. If you are on Interstate 90 coming west, take the Ramsay Exit west of Butte. It is exit #219 and you will want to be on I-15 headed south to Dillon. You will stay on I-15 to Exit #102, Route 43 to Wisdom. You will follow this over Chief Joseph Pass and catch up to Highway 93. You want to head north on Highway 93 to the Conner Cut off Road (I think this will take you about one hour). You will turn left on the Conner Cut off Road and follow it to Route 473. It will be about one or two miles. You will turn left again on Route 473 named the West Fork Road and follow it to mile marker 14. If you find yourself in the town of Darby, don't panic. You can head south for five miles and pick up Route 473 just as described below.\*\*

From the North and the West:

You will need to be on Highway 93 heading south through Hamilton and Darby. Five miles south of Darby, Montana is Route 473, also known as the West Fork Road. Turn west on the West Fork Road and follow it for 14 miles.

\*\*At the 14 mile marker is the Nez Perce Road branching off the West Fork Road on the right hand side. You need to be on the Nez Perce Road for the remaining 50 miles to Paradise. It will be gravel for 10 miles, the next 14 miles are paved (over the pass) and the last 25 miles the road is a single lane gravel road. The signs have Paradise marked on them. Our base camp is at the very end of the road. There is a public campground about \_ mile below our base camp. This trip takes about four hours from Missoula, and you don't need a 4-wheel drive unit between the middle of May and usually the middle of October.
